QUICK START 5 ESSENTIALS FOR SUCCESS

We know you're busy — and some of you are already off and running. These five actions are the essentials: tick them off now, or revisit them if you've started, to make sure your campaign is set up for success.

1. PERSONALISE YOUR PAGE

Log in, upload a friendly photo (bonus points in an apron!), add a few lines about why you're supporting OzHarvest, and set a clear fundraising goal.

A personal touch makes people far more likely to donate.

2. MAKE THE FIRST ASK

Momentum matters. Reach out personally to one or two close contacts today and ask them to donate.

Getting early donations to your page builds momentum and shows others it's worth supporting.

3. MAKE YOUR TOP 20 LIST

Write down 20 people in your network who are most likely to give generously — close friends, business partners, colleagues, clients. Reach out personally with a call, coffee, or tailored email. These "anchor donors" will kickstart your total.

4. SHARE YOUR FIRST POST

Use our ready-made social tiles and add your personal link. Keep it simple: tell people why you're doing CookOff and invite them to be part of it. Your first post sets the tone and opens the door for donations.

5. PLAN YOUR THANK-YOU

Decide now how you'll thank donors (quick email, call, or even a short video). A sincere thank-you within 48 hours builds trust and encourages more support. Gratitude is your secret fundraising weapon.

THE WHY

PURPOSE & INSPIRATION

THE NEED

Using the Talking Points

These headline facts are here to back you up. They add urgency and credibility to your message — but only work if you use them with purpose.

- In conversation Drop a stat into your personal story.
 Example: "Right now, 3.4 million households are struggling to put food on the table that's why I'm stepping into the kitchen for CookOff."
- On social Use one fact at a time alongside your fundraising link. Clear, punchy numbers make your posts stand out and give people a reason to act.
- With your team or clients Pull one or two figures into a slide or meeting to show the scale of the problem, then connect it directly to your fundraising goal.
- When thanking donors Show them the difference their gift makes. Example: "Your \$100 donation = 200 meals for people doing it tough."

Tip: Don't reel off every stat. Choose the one that fits your story and make it count.

NETWORKS & ENGAGEMENT



THE WHO: YOUR TOP 20

IMMEDIATE NETWORK

Write down 20 people in your immediate network who are most likely to give generously — family, close friends, business partners, key colleagues, or long-standing clients.

WHY IT MATTERS

The first donations set the tone.
When people visit your page and see support already flowing, they're far more likely to join in.

HOW TO REACH THEM

Personal outreach works best — a direct phone call, a quick coffee, or a tailored email explaining why you're doing CEO CookOff®.

TIP

Make your first ask today. Securing even a few early pledges builds visible momentum and builds your campaign.

THE POWER OF THE PERSONAL ASK.

People give to people; your voice and sincerity can move someone much more than a generic appeal.

While mass emails and posts are useful, one-on-one requests are often the most effective. Identify 10-20 individuals who are likely to donate generously (close friends, high-net-worth colleagues, business partners, etc.), and reach out personally – a phone call, a tailored email, or a coffee chat.

When approaching donors, be specific:

"I'm aiming to raise \$10k, and I'd be honored if you would consider contributing \$1,000 to help me reach that goal."

Don't be shy about suggesting a significant amount – if you know they care about community issues, they will appreciate the directness and the chance to make a big impact.



THANK YOUR SUPPORTERS



THANK THEM QUICKLY & WARMLY.

Sending a personal thank-you within 24–48 hours of a donation shows genuine gratitude and reassures your supporter that their gift made an impact.

At OzHarvest, we know that a heartfelt thank-you isn't just polite — it's powerful. Taking the time to acknowledge someone personally can strengthen relationships and inspire them to give again.

Your fundraising page allows you to thank supporters directly.

PROVIDE THEM UPDATES.

Send periodic updates on your progress: "We're halfway to the goal!" or "Thanks to you, I've raised \$2,500 which equals 5,000 meals delivered!"

These updates remind people their support matters.

It might also encourage those who haven't donated yet to jump in when they see the momentum.

STAY ACCESSIBLE.

Let your network know they can approach you with any questions about the cause or how to donate.

Being an active champion means not just asking for funds, but also being ready to discuss the mission and invite others to care about it as you do.

This builds trust and might convert interested prospects into donors.



TOOLS & FIRST STEPS



SET UP YOUR TOOLS.

Log in to your CEO CookOff® fundraising page and customise it. Upload a friendly photo (maybe in an apron!), write a few sentences about your mission, and be sure to include those powerful impact facts (meals delivered, etc.).

A well-presented fundraising page serves as the hub for your campaign – OzHarvest's platform is user-friendly and even allows team fundraising or company branding if needed.

If your company is involved, consider creating a team page so employees and colleagues can fundraise alongside you or on sub-teams.

PLAN YOUR TIMELINE.

Break your fundraising period (from now until the CookOff event in October) into phases with minigoals.

For example: "Raise \$3k by end of this month, hit \$7k by next month, and cross \$10k by event day."

Planning milestones keeps you on track and gives you reasons to update and re-engage your network. Mark key dates in your calendar for outreach pushes (we'll provide a suggested communications calendar in the follow-up social media toolkit).

GET THE TEAM ON BOARD.

Don't do it alone – involve your executive team, EA, or a passionate employee in your fundraising strategy.

As a leader, empowering others within your company to help will not only lighten your load but also amplify the reach. Host a kickoff meeting or send an internal memo announcing your participation and inviting ideas.

You might even form a small "CookOff Crew" in your office to help organize activities or cheerlead the effort internally.

TIPS FROM A TOP FUNDRAISER

Meet Wayne Bunz, National Director at CBRE Hotels, returning for his third CEO CookOff®. A passionate supporter of the event, Wayne has consistently ranked among the top fundraisers, previously claiming the #1 spot in Queensland.

His secret? Keep it personal, clear, and confident:

- Share your why make it authentic and meaningful.
- Ask once, clearly let people know exactly what their support achieves.
- Make it personal reach out individually, not with mass emails.
- Leverage your network colleagues, clients, friends, family, even community groups.

Wayne proves that when you connect your story to the cause, people respond.

PROVIDE EASY WAYS TO GIVE.

DIRECT LINK

Include the direct link to your fundraising page in all communications (emails, social posts, etc.).

Your link can be copied directly from your dashboard.

FIND YOUR QR CODE

Log in to your CEO CookOff® page, click your name in the top right corner, and under Get Support you'll find a link to download your personalised QR code. Share it on posters, emails or at events so supporters can scan and donate instantly.

EASY ACCESS

For in-person asks, have a QR code handy that links to your page - put it on flyers, or even your business card. Your QR Code can be copied from the dashboard.


SMART GIVING

Mention that donations are tax-deductible.

OzHarvest is a registered charity, so gifts of \$2 or more are deductible for Australian donors.

FLEXIBLE SUPPORT

If some contacts prefer offline donations (e.g., by invoice or check), coordinate with OzHarvest on how to handle those and add them to your tally.



LEVERAGE COMPANY PLATFORMS

LEADING TOGETHER

Send a company-wide email or intranet post about your CEO CookOff® participation. Share your passion and invite employees to help you reach the goal. Many will feel proud to see their CEO leading by example in the community.

VALUES SPOTLIGHT

Use company newsletters, press releases, or external blogs to spread the word. A short feature about "Our CEO is cooking to fight hunger" can both raise funds and positively showcase your company's values.

Some <u>example copy is provided here</u> as a starting point.

VOICE MATTERS

Offer to speak for a few minutes at a staff town hall or team meeting about OzHarvest. Putting a human story to the cause (e.g., recount a visit to an OzHarvest program or a OzHarvest statistic) can rally more support.

Here are quick <u>60-second talking points</u> you can use.

IMPACT VOICE

Consider an external-facing story. For instance, a LinkedIn Pulse article about why you are personally investing time in this cause can attract donations from your broader network and even the public.

<u>Here is a draft article</u> as a starting point — make it your own so it reflects you.

GIVING THROUGH A PRIVATE ANCILLARY FUND (PAF)

A POWERFUL WAY TO SUPPORT

If you have a Private Ancillary Fund, it's a powerful way to support your CEO CookOff® fundraising.

OzHarvest is fully registered to receive PAF distributions, and any contribution made through your fund can be credited directly to your fundraising total.

How it works:

- Share OzHarvest's ABN and DGR status with your fund manager;
- Ask your fund manager to process the grant, noting your name and CEO CookOff® in the reference.
- Let our team know when the grant is made so we can ensure it's added to your page.

CREATIVE FUNDRAISING IDEAS

Break out of the usual fundraising mold and infuse some creativity and fun into your campaign! Here are several fresh ideas to inspire you and your team.

These can help engage different groups of people and potentially raise substantial funds. Pick one or two that fit your company culture or personal style, or brainstorm variations that suit you best.

Remember, the best idea is one that excites you and fits your network's interests. Don't hesitate to involve your team in brainstorming – employees often have brilliant creative energy when it comes to fun fundraising!

And whatever you do, share lots of photos and updates when you carry out these ideas; it entertains your supporters and gives you more content to keep the momentum going.

EXECUTIVE CHALLENGE

Turn your fundraising into a challenge or dare. For example, commit to a fun stunt if you hit a certain milestone – shave your head, wear a wacky costume to work, or take a pie in the face at the next board meeting. These playful challenges generate buzz.

AUCTION YOUR SKILLS (OR PERKS)

Think about what makes you special and share that gift! You could auction off a 'CEO for a Day' experience where someone gets to shadow you, or offer an hour of your expertise to your network. Have a personal talent? If you're a wine connoisseur, why not auction a private wine tasting session? Your unique skills – whatever they are – can make a real difference while supporting our mission.

COMPANY MINI-COMPETITIONS

Spark some friendly competition among departments or offices to support your fundraiser. For instance, each department could have an online tally to collect donations, with a prize like a team lunch for the department that raises the most.

DONATE A PERCENTAGE OF SALES

Turn business into impact

One of the simplest ways to boost your CEO CookOff® fundraising is by linking it directly to your business. By donating a small percentage of sales — or adding \$1 to every transaction — you can turn everyday business activity into meaningful impact.

This approach not only raises significant funds but also gives customers, clients, and staff the chance to feel part of the cause.

How it works

- Add \$1 to every transaction OR
- Pledge a small percentage of sales during a set period
- Direct those funds to your CEO CookOff® fundraising tally

Why it's effective

- Engages a wide audience customers, clients, and staff all feel part of the cause
- Simple, scalable, and easy to communicate
- Builds positive brand recognition while raising vital funds

Examples

- \$1 from every coffee sold this week = 500 extra meals
- 5% of October sales from one product line = thousands of meals delivered



PRO TIP

Promote the initiative through your company's social channels, website, and in-store signage. Celebrate milestones publicly (e.g. "Thanks to your support, we've raised 10,000 meals so far!").

GIVE IT UP CHALLENGE

Give up something small, like your daily coffee or treat for a week and donate the savings.

Ask your network to join in — small sacrifices can add up to big impact.

FRUIT & VEG STALL

Set up a pop-up stall in your office or foyer, stocked with quirky fruit and veg that might otherwise go to waste (think wonky carrots or oversized zucchinis).

Invite colleagues to "shop" for a bag of produce in exchange for a donation. It's colourful, fun, and perfectly in line with OzHarvest's mission to rescue good food and give it to people who need it most.

RECIPE

Collect favourite recipes from your team and turn them into a mini cookbook. Think Nonna's lasagna, Nani's biryani, Yiayia's moussaka, or Popo's dumplings.

Share the collection with your network in exchange for donations.

YELLOW DAY

Encourage everyone in the office to wear something yellow (OzHarvest colour!) for a gold coin donation. Bonus points for the boldest outfit.

OFFICE RAFFLE

Sell tickets for a fun prize (like an extra day off, better parking space, or dinner cooked by you). Draw it live for extra buzz.

COFFEE JAR CHALLENGE

Set up a jar in the office — ask staff to drop in the cost of their daily coffee for a week. Watch it add up quickly.

YELLOW BAKE SALE

Host a morning tea with all-yellow treats (cupcakes, lemon slice, mango tarts).

Donations go straight to your CEO CookOff® tally.

PRIZED AUCTION

Auction off the CEO's parking spot (or another prized item) for a week or a month. Staff will happily bid for convenience!



THE BLACK APRON CLUB


Since CEO Cookoff® commenced less than 200 people have ever achieved it. \$10K raised = 20,000 meals for Australians in need.

It's not about knife skills or how well you can cook. It's about stepping up as a leader, showing generosity, and raising \$10,000, which equals 20,000 meals delivered by OzHarvest to people who need them most.

Earning a Black Apron means joining a small group of CEOs who have gone above and beyond. To date, less than 200 people have ever achieved Black Apron status, making it a rare and powerful badge of honour.

The Black Apron represents commitment, care, and a belief that every Australian should have access to good food.

When you see someone wearing the Black Apron, you know they've made a profound impact — not just in the kitchen, but in the lives of thousands of people across the country.



For example,
